Caleb S. competed in Heavy Equipment Operation which required him to complete a series of stations where he operated or inspected construction and surveying equipment, participated in an interview, and completed a written exam to assess knowledge of principles, theories, and procedures used in heavy equipment operation. Sawyer W. competed in the Masonry competition which included a skills performance assessing his ability to safely construct a composite brick and block project with details typically found in residential and commercial construction. Additionally, Sawyer completed a written exam assessing mastery of brick masonry techniques including use of hand tools, power tools, measuring equipment/tools, and blueprint reading. What an amazing experience this was for our students.

Pickle Party in Ms. Reed's 3rd Grade Classroom

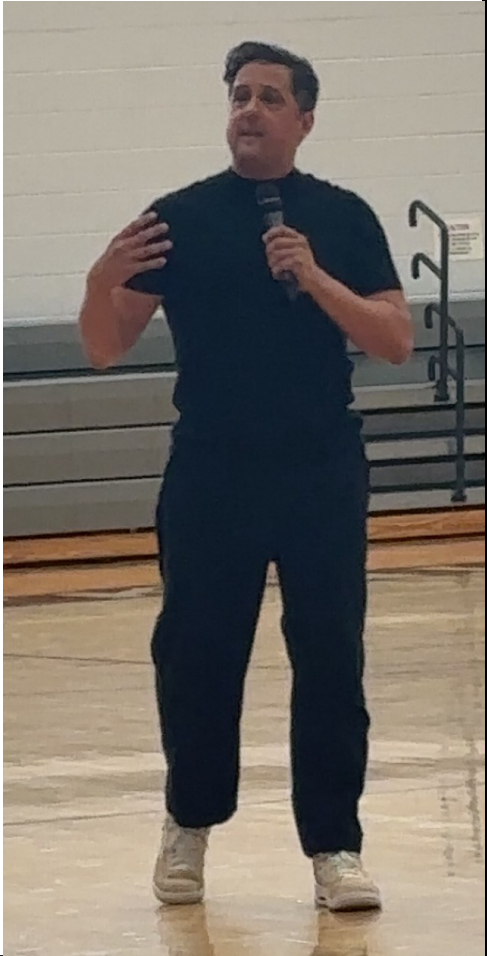

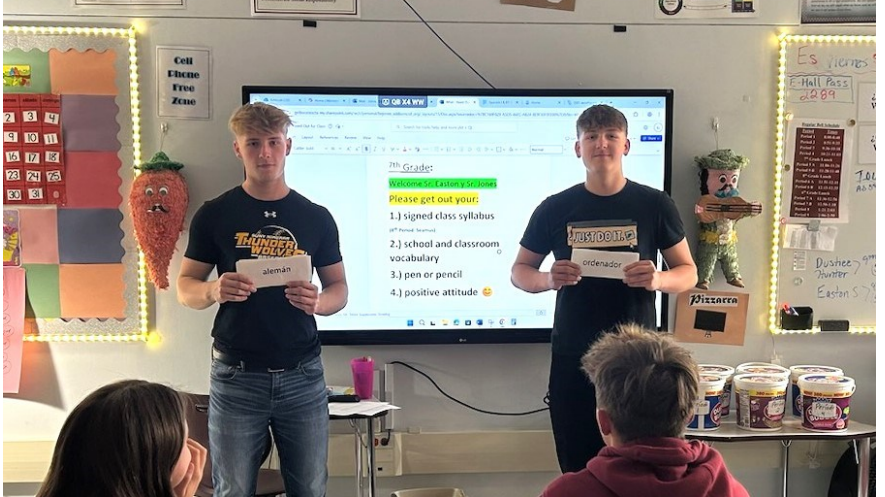


**Valley Early Childhood School**
